

Rondelet hits Rice, Spring springs

Rondelet has been misrepresented on the CR's calendar. The weekend will be the 28th, 29th, and 30th of April.

Activities will begin Friday at 7 pm in the Grand Hall of the RMC with the Songfest — all colleges will present a choral program and a novelty act.

From 9 pm until 12, at 319 McGowen, will be a Beer Grub, entertainment provided by The Blox. All women students will have a special 1 am permission that night.

Saturday at 10 am, Mrs. K. S. Pitzer will have a two-hour coffee for all women students at the Pitzer's campus residence. At noon, a luncheon for all the honorees and their dates will be held at Kaphans.

That afternoon, the real competition begins: at 2, the Tea-Trike relay, followed by the men's colleges' Beer-Bike mara-

thon.

Later that evening, at 9 pm in the Grand Ballroom of the Rice Hotel, will be the Rondelet Formal. This year the Rondelet Committee has rented a hall with an 800-person capacity to avoid the crowding and confusion of last year's over-capacity crowd of Rice revelers.

The Jimmy Simons Orchestra will be alternating intermissions with The Strings and Things to entertain the varied tastes of Rice music lovers.

The Rondelet Pageant will begin at 10 pm, and no one will be admitted to the hall until the presentation ceremonies are completed at about 10:30, so come early or come late. Honorees from Rice and all the Southwest Conference schools will be presented as well as the Rondelet Court and Queen.

The Rondelet theme is "Geometrics." Honorees will be

wearing black and white polka dot dresses and the Queen and her Court an accenting yellow.

Sunday

Sunday dinner will be a picnic in the men's quadrangle. No dinner will be served at the women's colleges, so they will be routed and equally distributed to Baker, Hanszen, Will Rice, and Weiss — girls with dates may eat with the men of their choice.

Non-Rice students or guests may buy tickets to this picnic for \$1.25 in the RMC beginning Monday, April 24th. Tickets for all Rondelet activities (the Formal and the Grub) will be sold in the RMC from Monday until Friday and in the men's colleges at dinner, Monday through Thursday.

Tickets for the Formal are \$5.00, tickets for the Grub are \$3.50. Tickets and dates, of course, may be obtained individually or compositely.
