Last year she was the concerto winner for both the Clear Lake Symphony and the Greater Houston Youth Orchestra Competitions.

Since August 1997, she has studied in the Shepherd School Preparatory Program with Zachary Carrettin and Kenneth Goldsmith. Liz performed in the Alice-Flores Sonata Competition, winning third place in violin in 1996 and honorable mention in 1997. This year she placed third in the Houston Music Teachers Association Senior Violin Competition. Liz was Concertmaster at the University of Texas-Austin Summer Music Camp Orchestra in 1997. Currently she is in the National Honor Society and the Latin National Honor Society at Cypress Falls High School, where she is a junior. She belongs to several clubs, including the Latin Club and Future Medical Careers, and she volunteers at local elementary schools, Cypress Fairbanks Medical Center, and Bear Creek Library. Her college goal is to study music.

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KIMARA KUSPA began her cello studies two years ago. She is ten years old and is involved in Girl Scouts, martial arts, art, and creative writing. Last summer Kimara participated in the Suzuki Conservatory Program led by Diane Bonds. Kimara is a student of Lisa Vosdoganes in the Shepherd School Preparatory Program.
