

SAR WILL SPONSOR ORATORY MEET

The Rice Forensic society will hold a preliminary contest March 10 to select an entrant in the Sons of the American Revolution oratory competition, to be held in Corpus Christi March 21.

The subject of the orations, which must be written by the contestants, is "Proper Functions of Legislative, Judicial and Executive Branches of Government under the U. S. Constitution."

The winner of the contest held at Rice will compete in the state

contest at Corpus Christi. Prizes are offered in amounts of \$150 for first place, \$125 for second, \$100 for third, and \$75 for fourth.

In addition, each contestant who does not win a prize will receive \$50 to cover travel expenses to Corpus Christi.

The winner of the Rice contest must have a written copy of his oration to submit to SAR one week before the state contest. The orations should be not less than 12 nor more than 15 minutes in length.

Judges for the contest at Rice will be members of the faculty.

The contest, Tuesday, March 10, will be held in Anderson Hall at 7:30 pm. Anyone wishing to

enter should notify Mr. J. D. Thomas in the English Dept. in Anderson Hall before noon of March 10.
